Dear Counselor:

As CEO of East Kentucky Network, LLC, d/b/a Appalachian Wireless, I am delighted to announce that we will again offer a scholarship program to eligible high school seniors. Our parent company, East Kentucky Network, established the Appalachian Wireless Scholarship program to help ease the burden on our customers for the costs associated with higher education for their children. Therefore, only students who are customers or whose parent or guardian has been a customer of Appalachian Wireless for at least the past 12 months will be eligible to apply.

The Scholarship Program will provide \$9,000 to graduating seniors who live and attend high school within the counties of our home service area. Nine high school seniors will receive a one-time scholarship of \$1,000 for higher education costs such as tuition, books, housing, or meal charges. The Scholarship will be awarded based on financial need, academic performance, school and community involvement, personal essays, and letters of recommendation.

Enclosed, please find an application that you may reproduce and distribute to the eligible graduating seniors in your school who will pursue higher education following graduation. You may also download a copy of the application from our website: www.appalachianwireless.com. A completed application must be postmarked by March 6, 2024.

An independent panel will review the application materials and notify you if your school's student is selected. Please keep the announcement confidential until your awards ceremony, when a representative from Appalachian Wireless will make a special presentation.

2023-2024 Appalachian Wireless Scholarship Information

Eligibility Requirements

- 1. Applicant must live and attend high school within the Appalachian Wireless 28 county home coverage area. (Bell, Breathitt, Buchanan, Clay, Dickenson, Elliott, Estill, Floyd, Harlan, Jackson, Johnson, Knott, Knox, Laurel, Lawrence, Letcher, Lee, Leslie, Letcher, Martin, Magoffin, Morgan, Perry, Pike, Powell, Owsley, Whitley, and Wolfe).
- 2 Applicant's parents or legal guardian must be a current Appalachian Wireless customer who has received service for a minimum of 12 months, and is in good payment standing.
- 3. Applicant must be a senior graduating from high school in the Spring of 2024 and must enroll full-time in a post-secondary institution or higher education (two or four-year college/ university, business school, or vocational-technical school/institute) as a beginning freshman in the Fall of 2024.
- 4 Applicant cannot be an employee or an immediate family member of individuals who are employed with Appalachian Wireless, Inc., or East Kentucky Network, LLC, or affiliates, or Appalachian Wireless Authorized Dealer.
- 5. Applicant must have a 2.5 GPA(4.0 scale) at the time of application.

Selection Criteria

- Financial Need 45%
- Academic Achievement 25%
- School/Community Involvement 20%
- Personal Essay/Letters of Recommendation 10%

Selection Process

- 1. A scholarship committee will review each application. The committee will select **NINE** students to receive a \$1,000 scholarship and their decision is final. All applications become the right of Appalachian Wireless and will not be returned.
- 2 Yourguidance counselor will be notified in May if there is a winner from your school. All winners will be contacted by Appalachian Wireless and will receive recognition at their awards ceremony.

Scholarship Payment

- 1. All scholarship funds will be made payable to the institution of choice upon official notification of enrollment from the registrar.
- 2 The scholarship can be applied to tuition, housing, books or other college related fees.

- 2 All completed applications must be postmarked and mailed no later than **March 6,2024**.
- 3. The following items **MUST** be included with the application to consider it complete:
 - 1. High school transcript must be an official document and should include recent report on senior year as well as GPA and ACT or SAT scores (if taken).
 - 2 Three letters of recommendation: **two from a school official/teacher** and **one from a member of the community or a non-relative who knows you knows you well.** Letters should describe your school/community involvement, personal characteristics, and/or other factors supporting your candidacy. All letters must be typed.
 - other factors supporting your candidacy. All letters must be typed.

 3. One 8½ x 11" page typed essay entitled, "The reasons why I should receive this scholarship and the role it plays in helping me achieve my goals."
